THIS IS A WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY – PLEASE READ BEFORE SIGNING

In consideration of being allowed the use of Rosaryville Retreat Center's Archery Range and supplies, I, _____, the undersigned, acknowledge, appreciate, and agree that:

____ There is the risk of injury related to the use of these Archery Supplies, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular skills, equipment and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and,

____ I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,

____ I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for use of the Archery Range and Supplies; and,

____ I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS Rosaryville Retreat Center, employees and/or volunteers and guests WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY OR DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property associated with my presence and/or use of the canoes, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT.

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Archery Rules

1. DO NOT pick up equipment until you are told to do so.
2. NEVER release the string without an arrow on it. This is called “Dry Firing” and may damage the bow.
3. Treat bows and arrows with respect- they can be a lot of fun, BUT deadly if used improper or carelessly.
4. Be sure that your equipment is in good condition.
5. Be sure of your target and backdrop (What’s behind the target) before you shoot. There should not be any people, pets, or anything else in the area in or near your line of fire and target area.
6. Lay down your bow when you are finished shooting.
7. Always keep your arrows pointed at the target and don’t put an arrow in your bow until you are ready to shoot.
8. NEVER point a bow at anything you don’t want to shoot.
9. Use proper safety equipment – Arm guards and finger tabs.
10. NEVER shoot until you are told to do so and everyone must stop immediately upon signal from range officer or anyone who crosses in front of the shooting line or enters the target area.
11. NEVER cross the firing line until the ALL CLEAR signal is given.
12. NEVER shoot an arrow into the air.
13. Wear suitable clothing. They should be close fitting so that nothing can get caught on the bow or bowstring as it is released. ALL participants should remove any necklaces before shooting.
14. ALWAYS walk on the range, especially when carrying arrows.
15. ALWAYS practice courtesy and good sportsmanship and....
